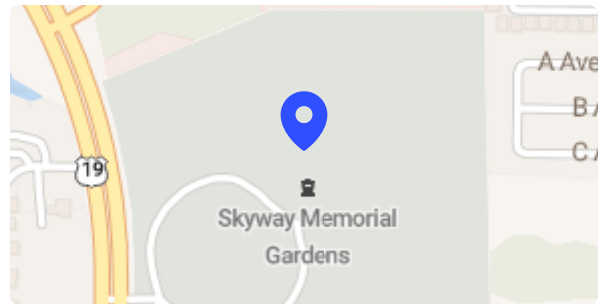

He will be laid to rest at Skyway Memorial Gardens in Palmetto, Florida.



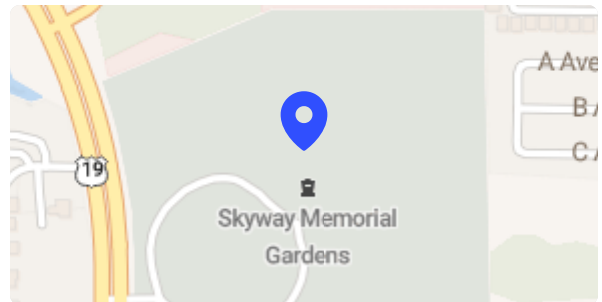
