All are encouraged and are welcome to join us in celebrating the life of Jack Covington.

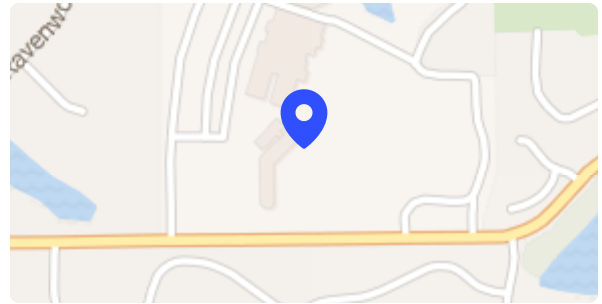
