# Robert Ray Weeks

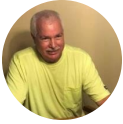

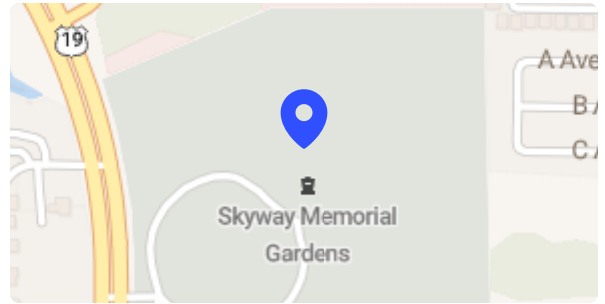

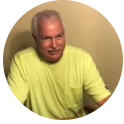
